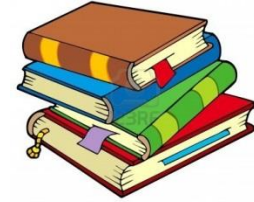

Summer Reading Requirements**



Summer reading is required for all high school students. Books have been chosen by grade level and are listed below. Students should read the book that corresponds with the grade they will be entering in the fall. Each student will need a hard copy of the book, not an e-reader version. All books should be available at Barnes and Noble. Some may also be available at 2nd and Charles. The books should be brought to class on the first day of school, and students should be prepared to be quizzed on the selection.

- 9th Grade: *The Pearl* by John Steinbeck
- 10th Grade: *Animal Farm* by George Orwell
- 11th Grade: *Of Mice and Men* by John Steinbeck
- 12th Grade British Literature: *Frankenstein* by Mary Shelley
- 12th Grade AP Literature: *Frankenstein* by Mary Shelley AND *Wuthering Heights* by Emily Bronte

It is important to note that all literature contains conflict. Some books may deal with sensitive topics or themes, or may use language that is not acceptable in daily society. Students are expected to deal with these themes maturely, both in their summer reading and in the classroom next fall. If you have any questions, please contact us.
